About the role

The Chair of the Editorial Advisory Board will:

- Help keep the journal up-to-date on innovations and best practice in public health research
- Advise, when necessary, on complex editorial appeals or research integrity issues

- Help recruit the broader International Editorial Advisory Board with a focus on seeking diversity on multiple fronts, including race, ethnicity, gender, professional background, and nationality

Candidates should have considerable experience in public health research (any area) along with a substantial publication record; a commitment to open access and advancing standards in public health research reporting and conduct, including via open science methods and principles.
